VACANCIES TO BE FILLED DURING THE 113th ASSEMBLY

PRESIDENT OF THE INTER-PARLIAMENTARY UNION

On 19 October 2005, the Governing Council will be required to elect a **new President** to replace Mr. S. Páez (Chile), whose term of office expires at the time of the 177th session of the Governing Council (Cf. Article 19 of the Statutes and Rules 6, 7 and 8 of the Rules of the Governing Council).

Candidatures, accompanied by a brief curriculum vitae, can be submitted up to Tuesday, 18 October at 2.30 p.m.

To date the following candidatures have been received:

- Mr. G. Versnick (Belgium): candidature submitted by the Twelve Plus Group and the IPU Group of Belgium;
- Mr. P.F. Casini (Italy): candidature submitted by the IPU Group of Italy.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

On 19 October, the Governing Council will be required to elect:

- (i) **Two members** to succeed to Mr. R. Salles (France) and Mr. I. Ostash (Ukraine) whose terms of office expire at the time of the 177th session of the Governing Council; and
- (ii) **One member** to replace Mr. S. Vejjajiva (Thailand) who has been appointed to ministerial office.

Candidatures from the corresponding geopolitical groups - <u>Twelve plus group, Eurasia group</u> <u>and Asia-pacific group</u> - accompanied by a brief curriculum vitae, can be submitted up to Tuesday, 18 October, at 2.30 p.m.

Committee on the Human Rights of Parliamentarians (permanent)

On 19 October, the Governing Council will be required to elect **one substitute member** to fill the post left vacant by Mr. M. Mottaki (Islamic Republic of Iran) who has been appointed to ministerial office.

Candidatures from the corresponding geopolitical group - <u>Asia-Pacific group</u> - accompanied by a brief curriculum vitae, can be submitted up to Tuesday, 18 October at 2.30 p.m.

Group of Facilitators for Cyprus (ad hoc)

On 19 October, the Governing Council will be required to elect **one facilitator** to replace Ms. J. Mackey (New Zealand), who is no longer a member of parliament.

Candidatures, accompanied by a brief curriculum vitae, can be submitted up to Tuesday, 18 October, at 2.30 p.m.

APPOINTMENT OF TWO AUDITORS FOR THE 2005 ACCOUNTS

On 19 October, the Governing Council will appoint **two Internal Auditors** for a one-year term. Parliamentarians interested in submitting their candidature for this position should preferably have prior experience either in a Parliamentary Finance or Audit Committee.
