PRESIDENT OF THE INTER-PARLIAMENTARY UNION

On 15 October 2008, the Governing Council will be required to elect **a new President** to replace Mr. P.F. Casini (Italy), whose term of office expires at the end of the 183rd session of the Governing Council (cf. Article 19 of the Statutes and Rules 6, 7 and 8 of the Rules of the Governing Council).

Candidatures, accompanied by a signed covering letter and a brief curriculum vitae, may be submitted up to Tuesday, 14 October at 2.30 p.m.

To date the following candidatures have been received:

- Mr. T.-B. Gurirab (Namibia): candidature submitted by the National Assembly of Namibia on behalf of the Southern African Development Community (SADC) Parliamentary Forum;
- Mr. A. Laksono (Indonesia): candidature submitted by the House of Representatives of Indonesia.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Committee on Middle East Questions

APPOINTMENT OF TWO INTERNAL AUDITORS FOR THE 2009 ACCOUNTS

On 15 October, the Governing Council will appoint **two Internal Auditors** for the 2009 fiscal year. They will report in Spring 2010. Parliamentarians interested in submitting their candidature for this position should preferably have prior experience either in a parliamentary finance or audit committee.
