# **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

All delegates and accompanying persons must have a valid passport in order to enter the Kingdom of Thailand. For countries requiring visas, participants are requested to contact the nearest accredited Thai embassies or consulates to obtain a visa.

#### HOTEL ACCOMMODATION AND RESERVATIONS

For practical reasons, it is proposed that all participants stay at the hotel which is the venue for the seminar. Once the venue is determined, a hotel registration form will be posted on the IPU web site.

#### ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

In order to ensure an efficient reception service, all participants are kindly requested to provide adequate arrival and departure information, including dates, flight numbers and arrival and departure times to the host secretariat. A reception service will be provided for participants at Phuket International Airport from Wednesday, 30 August to Monday, 4 September 2006, to assist with arrivals/departures and transfers between the airport and the hotel. Transit arrangements will be provided for participants at Bangkok International Airport.

#### **SECURITY**

The host secretariat will provide all necessary security measures to participants. All participants are required to wear their identity badges at all times at the seminar and all official functions.

#### **MEDICAL SERVICES**
