VAW thematic visit Women Shelter house

Thirty one years ago a first shelter house for women who face violence in the family was founded in Vienna. Today there are 4 such houses as well as a number of appartments open to women victims of such violence. This initiative is managed by a private organisation but financed by the City of Vienna.

To protect the privacy of the women living in this shelter house, the Speakers should only be accompanied by one person from their delegation, who should be a woman. Men are usually not supposed to enter.

The transport will be organised from the parliament to the shelter house and then directly back to the hotel Sacher. For the male participants the meeting will end after the afternoon session in the parliament.
